## **About the Wild Things CDs**

The idea of the first CD was to celebrate great music being made by people with learning disabilities in the UK. The word about this CD got out, and artists from other countries asked if they could get involved. As a result the follow-up featured artists from a variety of countries.

## **The aim of Wild Things 3**

This time round we want to include an equal number of artists from the 5 'Olympic' continents: Africa, Asia, Australasia, America and Europe.

These are the rules:







- 1) There are no rules about the musical style of your song
- 2) We want to feature artists where people with learning disabilities take a leading role in the creative process; that the music being made is clearly led by people with learning disabilities.
- 3) We want to promote the work of younger artists, but will welcome entries from musicians of all ages.
- 4) The recording quality does not matter – studio and bedroom recordings were featured on both the first two CDs
- 5) All songs must be submitted on CD or sent as a WAV or AIFF file by [www.yousendit.com](http://www.yousendit.com) (or similar). Unfortunately we are unable to accept DVDs
- 6) All sections of the entry form must be completed.
- 7) ALL songs must be original and you must have been given permission by the author to use their song.
- 8) All proceeds from any sales will go towards further promoting the Stay Up Late campaign ([www.stayuplate.org](http://www.stayuplate.org))

We promise to listen to all music sent in and will do our best to include your work. However, we want to make sure there is a wide spread of countries represented and can't promise to include everything.

- **If you are included on the CD we will provide you with 5 free CDs. Further copies will be available at £3 each.**
- **Any funds raised will be used to cover production costs and to fund further Stay Up Late activities.**

**Heavy Load will make the final decision on which songs to include. We will aim to provide feedback and comments on all entries to let you know why you have or have not been included. (If we're overwhelmed with entries, we'll try and arrange some additional online presence for the wider 'Wild Things Community').**

**As we don't know what the interest will be we are inviting entries from everyone, even if you were on the last two compilations. However, we will need to give priority to new artists, we hope you'll understand.**
